A Calm and Healthy Start



1. Give Them a Calm Start

Moving to a new home can feel overwhelming. For the first 1–2 weeks, keep your kitten in a quiet room with everything they need. Spend time nearby, but let trust build naturally.



2. Feeding & Nutrition

Feed a high-quality kitten food until about one year of age unless your veterinarian advises otherwise. Oriental Shorthairs should stay lean and muscular—you should be able to feel, but not sharply see, the ribs.



3. Exercise & Enrichment

These cats are active, curious, and social. Offer daily play, climbing options, and window views. If your cat becomes quiet, stops eating, or loses interest in play, contact your veterinarian.

4. Grooming & Nail Care

The Oriental Shorthair's short coat is easy to maintain. Occasional bathing is fine, but regular brushing is usually minimal. Trim nails weekly and handle paws gently and often to keep nail care stress-free.



5. Litter Box Habits

Provide multiple clean litter boxes in quiet, easy-to-reach places. Scoop daily and fully wash boxes regularly. Clean boxes help preserve good habits.



6. Veterinary Care & Vaccinations

Choose a veterinarian who understands, or is willing to learn, the Oriental Shorthair's slim body type. Keep your kitten on a regular wellness and vaccination schedule.

7. Scratching

Scratching is normal and necessary. Provide sturdy sisal posts or cardboard scratchers in several areas of the home.



8. Love, Conversation & Companionship

Oriental Shorthairs thrive on connection. Talk to them, play with them, cuddle them, and make them part of your daily life. They will be your companion for years to come.
